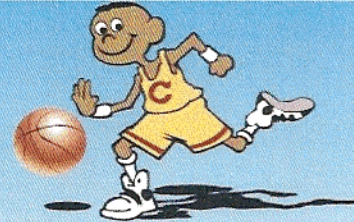

Challenged Youth Sports Inc. is a not for profit organization that provides recreational sports programs for children with special needs. Located in the Lincroft/Middletown, New Jersey area, the program is offered to boys and girls ages 7 and up with any type of disability. Currently, the program offers Soccer in the fall, Basketball in the winter, and Little League Softball and Tennis in the spring. We pay for dances, ice skating parties, and bus trips to Yankee Stadium for the children in our program. We exist through the volunteer assistance of adults and teenagers in the community. Enclosed is a picture of our volunteer teens with the players in our program.

We are in the process of raising funds to build our second playground, *Tony's Place*. This new playground is anticipated to go out to bid this fall and planned for completion first quarter 2009. It will be built at Seven Presidents Park in Long Branch, NJ. The playground will be accessible to children of ALL abilities. The unique ramped design allows children in wheelchairs to traverse the playground, making it different from most other playgrounds. The playground will be equipped with sensory perception devices and other enhancements that make it "way cool" to any child!

Challenged Youth Sports has no paid employees (we are 100% volunteer!). Every dime that is donated goes to the children. Not many non-profits can say that.
